

A Musical Note ...

Did you notice anything different at Mass this past Sunday? During the season of Lent there is no Gloria sung unless it is a Feast or Holy Thursday, and there is no Alleluia until the Easter Vigil. The musical tone of the Liturgy is also more reserved for a



specific reason. According to the current edition of the Roman Missal (2000/2003), No. 313 the use of the organ and other musical instruments during Lent are to be used only to support the sung parts of the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy. This is done to preserve the penitential character of the season. Exceptions to this directive are Solemnities and Feasts and the Fourth Sunday of Lent called Laetare Sunday, taken from the Latin *laetari* "to rejoice".


