

LECTURA: ¿Qué dice el texto?

Con el Domingo de Ramos se da inicio a la Semana Santa, en este día conmemoramos la entrada mesiánica de Jesús a Jerusalén, a pocos días de su Pasión, muerte y posterior resurrección.

El texto en este caso es del Evangelio de San Marcos, y comienza realizando una aproximación al contexto geográfico, Jesús estaba al pie del Monte de los Olivos, donde más tarde allí será arrestado, y cerca de los pueblos de Betfagé y de Betania, esta ultima era la ciudad del encuentro de Jesús y sus amigos Lázaro, María y Marta.

Jesús llega a Jerusalén, y con el la plenitud de la promesa de Dios a su Pueblo, ingresa como Rey, pero como un Rey humilde, subido a un asno, sobre un camino alfombrado por mantas y ramas que el pueblo arrojaba para ensalzarlo.

Durante su vida publica, en sus palabras, obras y gestos, muchos conocieron y creyeron que era el Mesías tan esperado por el Pueblo de Israel, y en este ingreso "triunfal", Jesús quiere cerrar su misión tambien mostrándose como Rey, y confirmando su condición de Mesías. Es así que la gente aclamaba al Señor, a través de distintas expresiones, entre ellas una de las palabras que se repetía era "Hosana", que es una aclamación de júbilo que significa "Salva".

"Bendito el que viene en el nombre del Señor", es una expresión claramente mesiánica, si además tenemos en cuenta que se hace mención a David, de donde el Mesías iba a surgir según la esperanza del Pueblo de Israel.

Jesús, lo primero que hace una vez en la ciudad, es dirigirse al templo, y dice la palabra que una vez que observó todo, salió con los doce hacia Betania. Jesús emprende el camino que lo llevaría a su "hora", el camino de la Cruz, para dar cumplimiento y plenitud a su misión.

MEDITACION: ¿Qué me dice a mí el texto?

- 1. La entrada de Jesús a Jerusalén implica una preparación previa de sus discípulos en este caso a través del asno. ¿Cuál es la preparación previa que debo hacer para ingresar con Jesús en esta semana Santa? ¿Qué cosas debo dejar afuera? ¿Y cuales debo llevar conmigo para caminar con fuerza y seguridad, para llegar al Domingo de Resurrección? ¿En este caminar de Semana Santa, voy solo? ¿Hay alguien en mi entorno que no está del todo animado, y necesita de mí para acompañarlo en esta semana Santa?
 - 2. ¿Qué espero de mí en este camino? ¿Creo que saldré igual, o más fortalecido?
- 3. ¿En que reconozco el paso del Señor en mí vida, durante esta cuaresma? ¿Tomo en cuenta el ejemplo del pueblo de Jerusalén, que responde al paso del Señor, con alabanzas? ¿Lo he hecho, o lo haré yo tambien? Fuente: https://es.aleteia.org/
