

Comentario

Hoy, cuando he preguntado: "Cuando dice Jesus estas palabras?" Todos mis hermanos y hermanas han coincidido en la respuesta: "Jesus dijo estas palabras durante su despedida final".

Para asegurarme de que había entendido la respuesta, he preguntado si por "despedida final" se referían al retorno de Jesus al Padre, a lo cual han respondido afirmativamente.

Sorpresa mayúscula! Estas palabras de Jesus pertenecen al capitulo 17 del evangelio de san Juan, justo un capitulo antes de que Jesus sea traicionado, apresado, negado, sometido a juicio, azotado, condenado, crucificado...

Jesus pide a sus discípulos que sean uno, que no se dividan, que sean santos ("Padre, santificalos"), incluso cuando ya sabia que le iban a traicionar, negar y abandonar. A partir de aquí, podemos entender que la "gran prueba" no es que los apóstoles pequen o no pequen. Jesus sabia que la fe de sus apóstoles era débil e iban a sucumbir a la tentación. La "gran prueba" a la que Jesus se esta refiriendo no es la de "no pecar" (lo cual seria imposible), sino la de afrontar el pecado "sin perderse", sin separarse, dividirse.

Jesus no vino a condenar a los que necesitaban reconciliarse y tampoco condena a sus discípulos antes del juicio que deberá soportar solo y abandonado por los suyos. Al contrario, les avisa, anima y aconseja para que cuando llegue el momento de la fragilidad, debilidad, pecado..., "no se pierdan"?!

Estas palabras de Jesus solo tienen sentido para nosotros si entendemos la flaqueza y debilidad de los apóstoles como un peldaño mas de su crecimiento espiritual. Es necesario que los apóstoles reconozcan su pecado para que acojan la "gracia" de Dios (que Jesus ya les había intentado explicar en las parabolas), no como un reconocimiento a sus méritos sino como una "elección" que no se merecen. Pero esto solo sera posible si no "se pierden", es decir, si permanence unidos y amándose como Jesus les ha amado.
