

Dear Friends,

John's account of the Resurrection in today's Gospel captures the initial excitement, fear, and uncertainty of the first believers of our Faith. Mary Magdalene, John and Peter meet at a crossroad of faith, having endured Christ's Passion and death from very different perspectives. In the wake of the crucifixion, they think they are beginning a new journey without Christ, after 3 years of journeying every step of the way with Him. The crossroad of fear and faith leads them to a place where God will manifest His glory in the Resurrection of His Son.

This is the Gospel: the empty tomb proclaims the truth of our human condition that we are no longer slaves to sin and death. The breath of the Risen Lord, the Word of God, proclaims Peace to every soul that cannot bear the consequence of sin, and no longer has to. Easter is the most important day because it is Eternal. And thanks be to God, we can contemplate the sacrifice of Jesus, and see Love in the purest form. Today, with Mary Magdalene we proclaim the Good News: The Lord is Risen! Alleluia!

Next week, the floor around the Baptismal font will look very different. Thanks to the generosity of parishioners who wish to remain anonymous, there will be a distinct area set apart from the rest of the tile in the Church. Ultimately it will be finished with mosaic tiles from Italy, that mirror the mosaics behind the altar, while also teaching the symbols of Baptism. It is an exciting addition to the body of our Church, and will allow us to ponder more deeply the mysteries of our faith.



PREP Registration for 2023-2024

Registration will begin in *late April* this year. We are transitioning to a new database, which will include online registrations and payments! More details will be provided as it is available. **PREP** is open to students in grades **Pre-K through 8**. Children who are older than 8th grade and who have not yet received their sacraments are also welcome to join us! There are two session options:



- † Wednesday evenings (weekly) from 6:45pm 8:00pm, (K to 8) OR
- † Sunday mornings from 10:15am 11:30am, (Pre-K to 8)
 - The Sunday session is structured as a Family Catechesis program. *Parents and students meet twice a month.* Lessons for the at-home catechesis are provided to the parents for the weeks when classes are not held.
 - Space is limited for our Sunday session!

<u>SACRAMENT NOTES:</u> The children will be prepared to receive the sacraments of <u>Reconciliation</u> and <u>Eucharist</u> for the first time in 2nd grade. It is a *two-year* preparation process. Children who are older than 2nd grade, and who have not yet received these sacraments, are encouraged to register as soon as possible. We will evaluate the best placement for them based upon classes available. The sacrament of <u>Confirmation</u> is conferred in 7th grade (or older, depending on when you begin the preparation process).



Queridos amigos

El relato que hace Juan de la Resurrección en el Evangelio de hoy capta la emoción, el miedo y la incertidumbre iniciales de los primeros creyentes de nuestra Fe. María Magdalena, Juan y Pedro se encuentran en una encrucijada de fe, tras haber soportado la Pasión y muerte de Cristo desde perspectivas muy distintas. Tras la crucifixión, piensan que comienzan un nuevo viaje sin Cristo, después de 3 años de recorrer cada paso del camino con Él. La encrucijada del miedo y de la fe les conduce a un lugar donde Dios manifestará su gloria en la resurrección de su Hijo.

Este es el Evangelio: la tumba vacía proclama la verdad de nuestra condición humana de que ya no somos esclavos del pecado y de la muerte. El aliento del Resucitado, la Palabra de Dios, proclama la Paz a toda alma que no puede soportar las consecuencias del pecado, y ya no tiene que hacerlo. La Pascua es el día más importante porque es Eterna. Y gracias a Dios, podemos contemplar el sacrificio de Jesús, y ver el Amor en estado puro. Hoy, con María Magdalena proclamamos la Buena Nueva: ¡El Señor ha Resucitado! ¡Aleluya!

La próxima semana, el suelo alrededor de la pila bautismal tendrá un aspecto muy diferente. Gracias a la generosidad de feligreses que desean permanecer en el anonimato, habrá una zona diferenciada del resto de baldosas de la Iglesia. En última instancia, se terminará con mosaicos de azulejos de Italia, que reflejan los mosaicos detrás del altar, mientras que también enseñan los símbolos del Bautismo. Es una adición emocionante al cuerpo de nuestra Iglesia, y nos permitirá reflexionar más profundamente sobre los misterios de nuestra fe.
