

Dear Friends,



#### We Thirst Series

We all know someone who has been touched by addiction. **We Thirst** is an inspirational series that educates about the topic of addiction from a Christian perspective. The program consists of five contemplative sessions, which are designed for all Christians, including the afflicted, their family and friends, and anyone who would like to learn more to become part of a solution to a problem that affects all of our communities. **We Thirst** explores the nature of addiction and our responsibility as followers of Christ, in responding to those who are suffering. These five sessions educate us about the biology, psychology, sociology, and spirituality of addiction and concludes with Action. *One attendee stated, "This program has been a miracle, after years of prayer."*


