

Dear Friends,

Congratulations to our parish families who celebrated First Holy Communion yesterday. We will recognize them at all Masses today although I have a feeling they won't be hard to recognize in their First Communion outfits. May is a month of celebrations in the Church. We not only have celebrations in our own parish, but a few of the seminarians who have been stationed here on Apostolate are celebrating milestones of faith at their home parishes. Next Saturday, seminarian Brendan Zehner, who stayed with us last summer and visited Mater Dei and many parishioners throughout the year, will be ordained a transitional Deacon at St. Martin's Chapel in St. Charles Borromeo Seminary. While this is an invitation only event, I have assured him that our parish will be praying for him as he enters Holy Orders and receives his first assignment from Archbishop Perez. I will invite him to preach at one of our Masses in the near future and will let you know the date and time. In two weeks, Deacon Kenneth Omeke, who stayed with us over the summer of 2021, is going to be ordained a priest at the Cathedral Basilica of SS Peter and Paul in Philadelphia. 




