

# From The PASION

Dear Friends,

Next weekend we are celebrating the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi. This also marks the end of the first year of the National Eucharistic Revival in the United States. The second year begins with an increased emphasis on revival at the parish level. To this end, the bishops have asked parishes to develop practices to foster Eucharistic devotion, strengthening our liturgical life through faithful celebration of the Mass, Eucharistic Adoration and organic movements of the Holy Spirit. At the conclusion of the 11:00am and 1:00pm Masses next weekend, we will end Mass with a small Eucharistic Procession, followed by silence in adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament. You may feel free to leave either Mass after the procession, however, we ask that you remain in silence until you leave the Church. Everyone is also encouraged to pray in silence in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, even if only for a few minutes after Mass. Throughout the next year, we will have increased moments of Eucharistic Adoration in the body of the Church. Ultimately, I would like a full outdoor Eucharistic Procession after Mass next year on the feast of Corpus Christi, culminating in a large parish picnic. If you would like to help or be part of the organic movements of the Holy Spirit to foster Eucharistic devotion, please reach out.


## Philly Adoration for Vocations Thursdays, 9am to 5pm


