


Dear Friends,

#### SPOTLIGHT THIS WEEK: SACRAMENTS



Children prepare to receive *Reconciliation and First Communion* for the first time in 2nd grade. They must complete the Level 1 faith formation curriculum prior to entering Level 2 to prepare for these two Sacraments. *Is your child Baptized and in 2nd grade or higher in public school or attending a private, non-Catholic school who has never been enrolled in a formal religious education program? No worries...it's never too late to begin preparing to receive the sacraments!* 

**Confirmation** is usually celebrated in 7th grade. Ongoing religious formation after receiving First Communion enables our young people to grow in both their spiritual lives and in their knowledge of the Catholic faith. This will not only help them to prepare to be confirmed but will also help them to be the *best* person God created them to be, encouraging them to witness to Jesus in ALL that they say and do throughout their lives! It is never too late to enter a formal faith formation program and to participate in the Church through the Sacraments. Please contact us if your son or daughter will be in 8th – 12th grade in the fall and has not yet been confirmed.





Do you have an older child who <u>has never been baptized</u>, or who may have been <u>baptized in another Christian faith</u> and who is interested in becoming Catholic? If you no longer had a relationship with your dad before he died, or if things were difficult between you both, you may find that your grief is more complicated. On holidays, when people often head to social media to show others how they're celebrating, you may experience a whole range of emotions. Having feelings of jealousy, envy, anger as well as sadness can be common, but not everyone talks about them openly. To all those suffering this day, the Bereavement ministry assures you of our prayers for comfort and reminds you that we offer monthly support groups to talk about these feelings. 
#### **Celebration of Marriage Retreat**
