



#### **RCIA** is Starting Soon!

If you or a family member or a friend are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, please consider joining our parish's RCIA program. The RCIA is the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, and it addresses the fundamental questions that we all have, based on our common human experience.

The program is an introduction to Catholic teaching and is focused on growing in relationship with Jesus Christ, by participating in a small faith-sharing community.

If you are a non-Catholic, or if you have been baptized but have not yet received any other sacraments, or if you are a practicing Catholic who wants to go deeper in learning about your faith, then RCIA could be a helpful step on your faith journey. Attending the program does not require a firm commitment right now, but is merely an opportunity to "come and see" what God might be calling you to.

Sessions will take place every Wednesday evening, from September through May, from 7:00pm to 8:30pm in the Parish Center, starting on September 6th. assigned to a classroom and has a book on the first day, please complete your registration *no later than September 5th.* Payment may be made after PREP begins. Thank you.


Children must complete the 1st grade level prior to entering Level 2


