




### PREP Classes start SOON...

Did you know that the celebration of Catechetical Sunday started in 1935? It is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of our Baptism, in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel. The 2023 Catechetical Sunday theme is "Come to Me, all you who labor and are burdened."

This year, Catechetical Sunday will be celebrated during the weekend of **September 16th & 17th**. There will be a special blessing of all catechists at all of the Masses that weekend. ## <u>Topic</u> - The Real Presence of the Holy Eucharist Why Your Mindset Matters

## **Speaker** - Dr. Nina Marie Corona



Are your beliefs about the Eucharist hindering your experience of God's grace in the sacrament? There's some exciting research coming out of Stanford University's Mind and Body Lab that might get you thinking in new ways about the Holy Eucharist and the Real Presence! This talk explores the current scientific research on mindset and the Church's teachings on the Eucharist. We will reflect and consider why paying attention to our beliefs is important, and we will be

inspired to be more active in "assenting to the divine truth," as stated in the Catechism. This presentation is not just a talk! It includes music and videos for a thought-provoking and spiritually moving experience.

## **RCIA** is Starting Soon!

If you or a family member or a friend are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, please consider joining our parish's RCIA program. The RCIA is the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, and it addresses the fundamental questions that we all have, based on our common human experience. The program is an introduction to Catholic teaching and is focused on growing in relationship with Jesus Christ, by participating in a small faith-sharing community.

If you are a non-Catholic, or if you have been baptized but have not yet received any other sacraments, or if you are a practicing Catholic who wants to go deeper in learning about your faith, then RCIA could be a helpful step on your faith journey. Attending the program does not require a firm commitment right now, but is merely an opportunity to "come and see" what God might be calling you to.

Sessions will take place every Wednesday evening, from September through May, from 7:00pm to 8:30pm in the Parish Center, starting on September 6th. 

Humanae Vitae is Pope St. Paul VI's famous 1968 encyclical on contraceptive and reproductive ethics surrounding the regulation of birth. Promulgated 55 years ago at a time when the sudden prevalence of contraceptive use created confusion among the faithful, Humanae Vitae provided us with grace-filled clarity about whether or not controlling one's fertility was appropriate in God's design for humanity. While Pope St. Paul VI's writings reaffirms long-held church teachings, the encyclical also explains how the Church's wisdom can be applied in a modern cultural context, especially in regards to marriage, parenthood, and other Christian vocations and professions.
