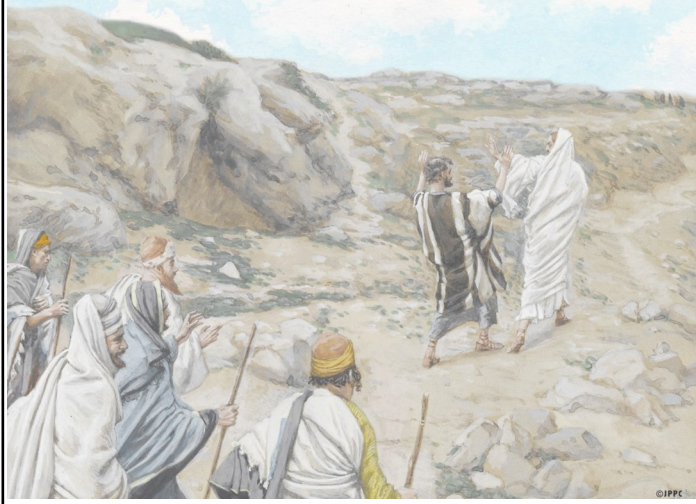

Dear Friends,

This weekend we welcome Fr. Mark Marangone, s.x., an Xaverian Missionary from the St. Francis Xavier Foreign Mission Society, who will be preaching the Mission Appeal at our parish as part of the annual Missionary Cooperation Plan. Fr. Mark was born in Italy and ordained a priest in 1984 in his hometown near Udine, some 70 miles northeast of Venice, and is a graduate of the Catholic Theological Union at Chicago. After 12 years of service in the USA, first in Wisconsin and then in New Jersey, he did 13 years of missionary work in Colombia, South America. For a couple of years, he served in Vocation Ministry in the Capital City of Bogotá, and then nine years in “La Encarnación” Parish. He returned to the USA in 2011 to serve as Local Superior of the Xavier Mission Society Center at Franklin, WI, and since May 2016 as Provincial Superior in Wayne, NJ.

The St. Francis Xavier Foreign Mission Society was founded in 1895 in Parma, Italy, by St. Guido Maria Conforti, under the patronage of St. Francis Xavier, SJ. It is exclusively a foreign mission society, with about 700 members coming from 17 countries and serving in 21. The Xaverian Missionaries (Priests and Brothers) depend greatly on proceeds from friends and benefactors. They began serving in mainland China in 1899 among non-Christians. Expelled from there in the early 1950’s, they were invited to serve in other countries in Asia, Africa and the Americas. They are involved in evangelization, interreligious dialogue, service to the most in need, formation of leaders, education et al. They carry out their service in Bangladesh, Brazil, Burundi, Cameroon, Chad, Colombia, the Democratic Republic of Congo, France, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Morocco (since October 2020), Mozambique, the Philippines, Sierra Leone, Spain, Taiwan, Thailand, the United Kingdom, and the United States. If you or a family member or a friend are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, please consider joining our parish's RCIA program. The RCIA is the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, and it addresses the fundamental questions that we all have, based on our common human experience. 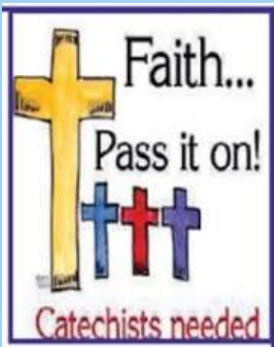

Sunday's PREP session begins at **10:15am** (doors open at 10:00am)

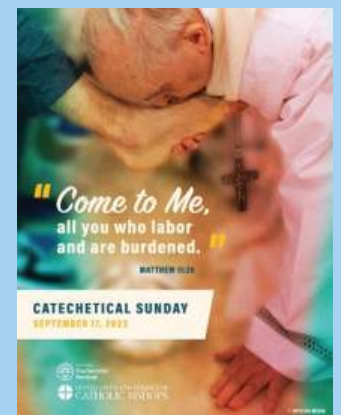

Mark Marangone, s.x., Misionero Javeriano de la Sociedad de Misiones Extranjeras San Francisco Javier, que predicará el Llamamiento Misionero en nuestra parroquia como parte del Plan anual de Cooperación Misionera. El P. Mark nació en Italia y fue ordenado sacerdote en 1984 en su ciudad natal, cerca de Udine, a unas 70 millas al noreste de Venecia, y es licenciado por la Catholic Theological Union de Chicago. Tras 12 años de servicio en Estados Unidos, primero en Wisconsin y luego en Nueva Jersey, realizó 13 años de labor misionera en Colombia (Sudamérica). Durante un par de años sirvió en la Pastoral Vocacional en la capital Bogotá, y luego nueve años en la Parroquia "La Encarnación". Regresó a los EE.UU. en 2011 para servir como Superior Local del Centro de la Sociedad Misionera Xavier en Franklin, WI, y desde mayo de 2016 como Superior Provincial en Wayne, NJ.

La Sociedad de Misiones Extranjeras San Francisco Javier fue fundada en 1895 en Parma, Italia, por San Guido Maria Conforti, bajo el patrocinio de San Francisco Javier, SJ. Es exclusivamente una sociedad misionera extranjera, con unos 700 miembros procedentes de 17 países y que prestan servicio en 21. Los Misioneros Javerianos (sacerdotes y hermanos) dependen en gran medida de los ingresos procedentes de amigos y benefactores. Comenzaron a servir en China continental en 1899 entre los no cristianos. Expulsados de allí a principios de los años 50, fueron invitados a servir en otros países de Asia, África y América. Están implicados en la evangelización, el diálogo interreligioso, el servicio a los más necesitados, la formación de líderes, la educación, etc. Llevan a cabo su servicio en Bangladesh, Brasil, Burundi, Camerún, Chad, Colombia, República Democrática del Congo, Francia, Indonesia, Italia, Japón, México, Marruecos (desde octubre de 2020), Mozambique, Filipinas, Sierra Leona, España, Taiwán, Tailandia, Reino Unido y Estados Unidos.
