


Yearning to Yarn?

Tony Melendez is a renowned singer and guitarist who plays with his feet. His music and uplifting story will inspire all. Originally from Nicaragua, Tony was born without arms and a clubbed foot due to the drug, Thalidomide, which his mother was prescribed for morning sickness with no idea how it would affect her unborn son. His family immigrated to the US when Tony was 1 so he could have corrective surgery on his foot to allow him to walk. Tony had to learn to do almost everything with his feet and at the age of 16 taught himself how to play the guitar with his toes, even playing for Pope John Paul II five times! His story is one of inspiration and hope.


