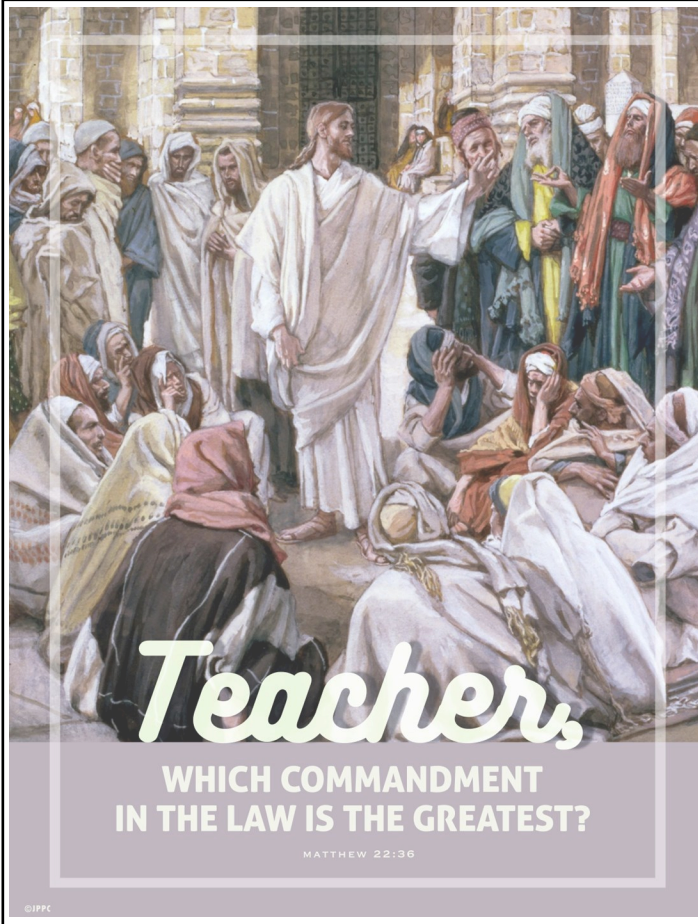

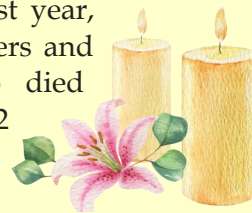
Annual We Remember Mass

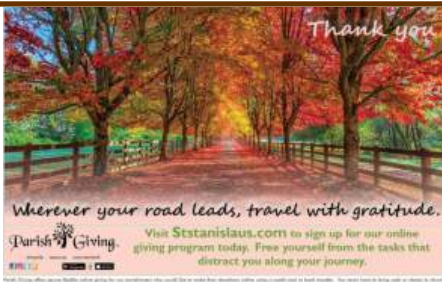

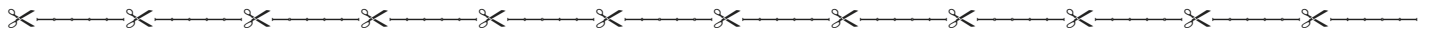
