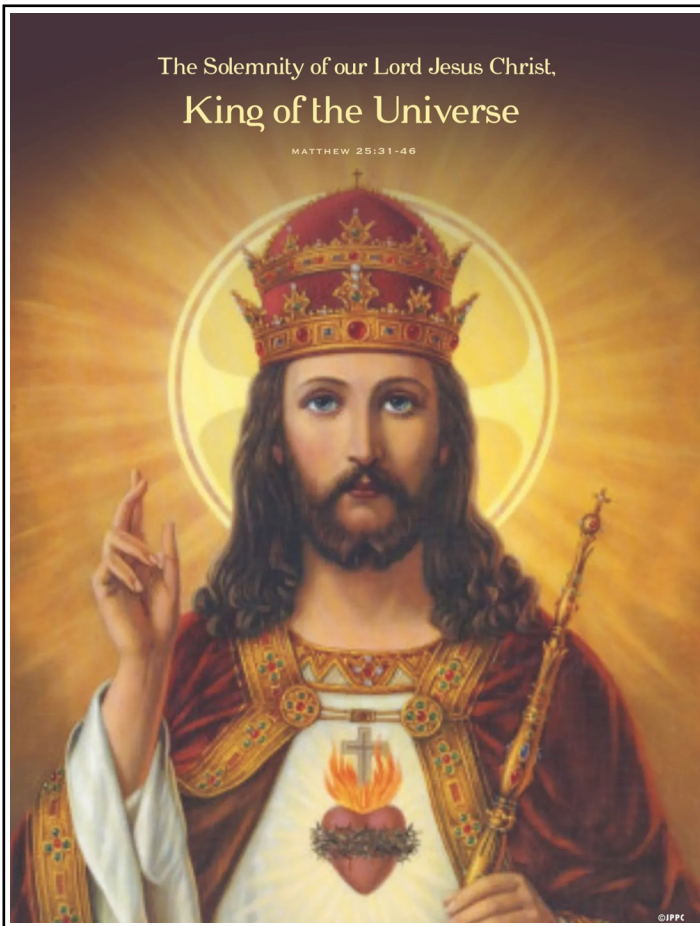

Dear Friends,

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. It is an important moment in our Church year for personal reflection on the priority of Jesus in our lives. As we begin a new Church year next weekend with the first Sunday of Advent, perhaps we can make small changes in our life to allow for the presence of Christ to become more abundant.

This weekend I will also be announcing the upcoming change of time for our Saturday Night Vigil Mass. Beginning the weekend of January 6, 2024, our vigil Mass will begin at 4:30pm. Confessions will be held an hour prior to Mass on Saturday afternoon at 3:30pm. I recognize that this may be a burden for some, but an informal poll over the summer provided a majority response for an earlier Mass time. I hope that this change will allow more people the comfort of knowing they can drive to Mass in some daylight during the winter months. We will have ample signage within and outside the Church to announce this change each week. We will also be publishing reminders in the bulletin, the website, Constant Contact and in the announcements at Mass. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

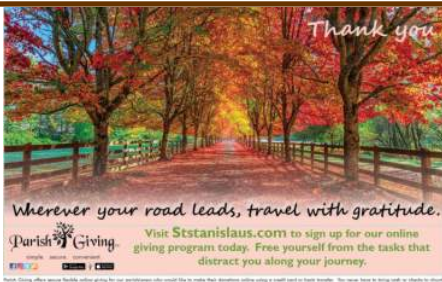

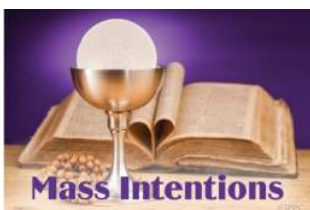
