From The PASTOR

Dear Friends,

Next weekend we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Advent, and immediately after, we celebrate Christmas Day. Every so often Christmas falls the day after Sunday. This creates some ambiguity with the schedule, and the obligation to attend Mass. We are obligated to attend Mass for the Fourth Sunday of Advent, and Christmas Day. This means that you will end up going to Mass twice next weekend (maybe even twice on Sunday). The first Mass would be on Saturday evening or Sunday morning for the Sunday obligation, then again in the evening for Christmas Eve or on Christmas Day. Spending time with the Lord at Mass is the greatest blessing we can receive.

This also creates an additional issue of decorating the Church for Christmas. Usually, we would never have Christmas decorations present in the Church for the Fourth Sunday of Advent. However, it is impossible to decorate the Church after the 1:00pm Spanish mass before the 4:00pm Christmas Vigil. Therefore, you will see the Church decorated for Christmas next weekend. We could use help decorating the Church beginning next Friday morning, December 22nd, at 10:00am, if you would like to lend a hand.

The Bereavement Ministry of MMR and St. Stanislaus Parishes

Here are some tips from the Bereavement Ministry for supporting someone who is grieving during the holidays:



1. Be supportive of the way the person chooses to handle the holidays. Some may wish to follow traditions; others may choose to avoid customs of the past and do something new. It's okay to do things differently.
2. Invite the person to join you or your family during the holidays. You might invite them to join you for a religious service or at a holiday meal where they are a guest.
3. Donate a gift or money in memory of the person's loved one. Remind the person that his or her loved one is not forgotten.
4. Never tell someone that he or she should be "over it." Instead, give the person hope that, eventually, he or she will enjoy the holidays again.
5. Be willing to listen. Active listening from friends and family is an important step to helping someone cope with grief and heal.
6. Remind the person that you are thinking of him or her and the loved one who died. Cards, phone calls and visits are great ways to stay in touch.
7. Follow up after the holidays to check in. Given the activity of the season, some people may make it through the holidays without any issues but they might find the post-holiday period to be more difficult. So checking in after the holidays to see how he or she may be doing is helpful.

Thank you in advance for your wonderful generosity! And blessings to you and your family in this holy season of Advent.





Queridos amigos,

El próximo fin de semana celebramos el cuarto domingo de Adviento, e inmediatamente después, el día de Navidad. De vez en cuando, la Navidad cae el día después del domingo. Esto crea cierta ambigüedad con el horario, y la obligación de asistir a Misa. Estamos obligados a asistir a misa el cuarto domingo de Adviento y el día de Navidad. Esto significa que acabará yendo a Misa dos veces el próximo fin de semana (puede que incluso dos veces el domingo).
