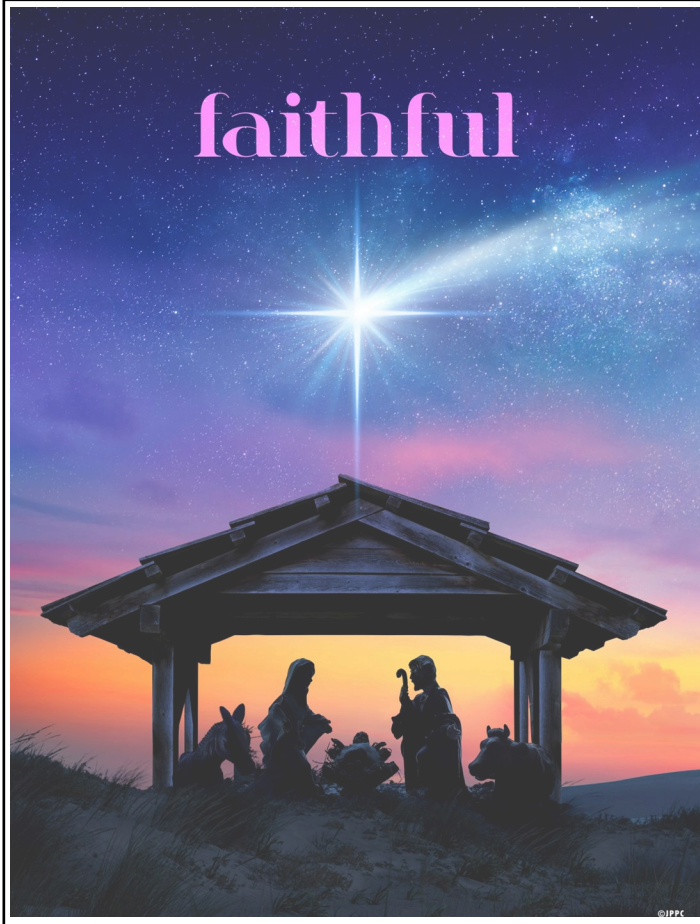

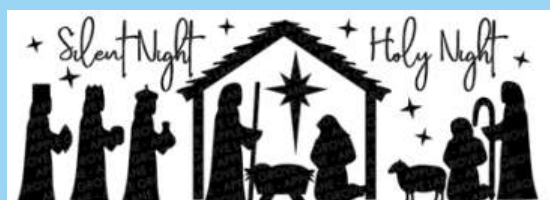

One thing they have learned is that only about 16% of women who have had an abortion have ever talked about their experience with someone in the Church. 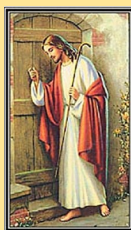

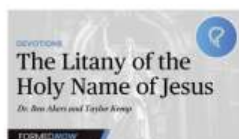

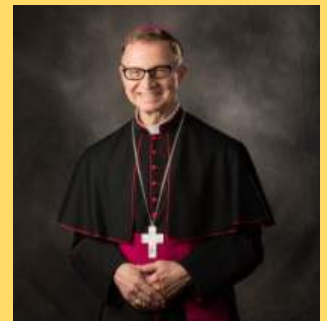
