

Compossionately Talking About Abortion

#### Tuesday, January 23rd at 7pm Parish Center

North Care Women's Clinic is a pregnancy clinic that seeks to walk alongside the church and offer expertise and insights from over 38 years of serving women in our local community facing unplanned pregnancy and considering abortion. One thing they have learned is that only about 16% of women who have had an abortion have ever talked about their experience with someone in the Church. Being pro-life means we have to be open to conversion and healing, and part of that is talking with compassion in the healing process. North Care is hosting a training session at our parish titled Compassionately Talking About Abortion. This one-hour training session is for Christians who want to make the Church a safe place for women facing unintended pregnancy and past abortions. Please consider attending.
