

Speaker - Deacon Jim Browne



Bioethics is a field of study that examines ethical issues and questions about biology and medicine. As Catholics, it's important that we apply the Church's moral and ethical teachings to concerns about end-of-life issues. This presentation will cover topics such as suffering and death from a Catholic perspective, bioethical tools, euthanasia, physician-assisted suicide, assisted nutrition and hydration, and the appropriate use of oxygen and ventilators. Our speaker, Deacon Jim Browne, is a certified bioethics consultant and is Chairman of the Archdiocesan Diaconate Bioethics Committee.

Host Families needed for NET Ministries Missionary Team

We are excited to be partnering with *NET Ministries* for our Confirmation Retreat this year! They are bringing a team of 11 missionaries to lead the

retreat. Not counting the supervisors, the team members range in age from 18 – 21. They do not live in our area, so we are looking for parish families to volunteer to host some of the team members for two nights. They will need somewhere to stay overnight on *Sunday*, *February 11th and Monday*, *February 12th*.

No missionary can stay alone – a minimum of two missionaries of the same gender must be housed together. There are 6 women and 5 men on the team. We are looking for <u>up to 5 households</u> to host the missionaries.

- ▶ *No extra bedrooms?* **No problem!** They bring their own sleeping bag, pillow, towel, and toiletries; therefore, floors, couches, or air mattresses work just fine. In the end, they need a roof over their head and shower access!


