





Did you know that an estimated 120 million people around the world need glasses and cannot afford them?

This month, St. Stanislaus Church is partnering with the Lansdale Lions Club, collecting donations of gently used prescription eyeglasses and readers.

Donated glasses are sent to the New Jersey Lions Eyeglass Recycling Center (NJLERC) for cleaning, screening, prescription testing, sorting, and shipping to missions around the world.

The NJLERC handles about 1.2 million pairs each year and is one of 18 centers worldwide -12 of which are in the US.

There will be collection boxes in both vestibules by the parking lot from March 16th to the 24th.




Archdiocesan Elementary Choral Concert


