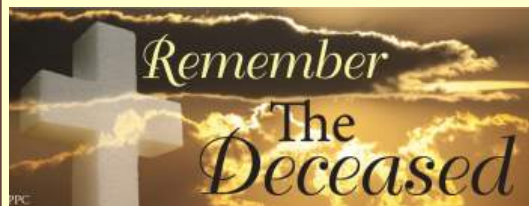

Did you know that an estimated 120 million people around the world need glasses and cannot afford them?

This month, St. Stanislaus Church is partnering with the **Lansdale Lions Club**, collecting donations of gently used prescription eyeglasses and readers.

Donated glasses are sent to the **New Jersey Lions Eyeglass Recycling Center (NJLERC)** for cleaning, screening, prescription testing, sorting, and shipping to missions around the world.

The NJLERC handles about 1.2 million pairs each year and is one of 18 centers worldwide - 12 of which are in the US.


There will be collection boxes in both vestibules by the parking lot from March 16th to the 24th.
