Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate Palm Sunday and enter into the solemn remembrances of Holy Week. At Mass we receive blessed Palm commemorating the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. During Holy week, we have special liturgies which re-present the salvific events of the Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection. Those events allow us to unite our own sufferings, sacrifices and thanksgivings to Jesus as he offers himself to our Father. We celebrate this reality every time we come to Mass, but in a particularly heightened way in the liturgies of Holy Week. This year, all of our liturgies during the Triduum will be bi-lingual (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil). It is a blessing to have a rich multi-cultural parish and we will experience that vibrancy in our celebrations this week. We will also have additional time for confession before the Paschal Triduum on Monday evening from 7-8PM. We will have additional priests to assist with the sacrament. This is the holiest time of the year and so I pray we may experience the great mystery of God's love in a unique and new way this Holy Week.





Jesus is calling us, to sit with him and to open our hearts to his Love and Mercy.




