




Registration will open on April 15th

PREP is open to students in grades Pre-K through 8. Children who are older than 8th grade and who have not yet received their sacraments are also welcome to join us!

There are two session options:

- + Wednesday evenings (weekly) from 6:45pm 8:00pm (K to 8)
- + Sunday mornings from 10:15am 11:30am (Pre-K to 8)
 - The Sunday session is structured as a Family Catechesis program Parents and students meet twice a month. Lessons for the at-home catechesis are provided to the parents for the weeks when classes are not held Space is limited for our Sunday session!



SACRAMENT NOTES: The children will be prepared to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist for the first time in 2nd grade. This is a two-year preparation process. Religious Education continues yearly after First Communion through 7th grade, when the students will receive the sacrament of *Confirmation* (or possibly older, depending on when they began the preparation process). Children who are older than 2nd grade, and who have not yet received their First Communion, are encouraged to register as soon as possible. We will evaluate the best placement for them based upon classes available.


