
Dear Friends,



#### PREP Registration for 2024-2025 IS OPEN!

**CURRENT PREP families** were sent an email from Parish Giving with a reminder of their unique login to re-register. **The link for NEW families to register is posted on the Parish website.** Feel free to also call us with questions. *We look forward to meeting you!* 

**PREP** is open to students in grades **Pre-K through 7th**. Children who are older than 7th grade and who have not yet received their sacraments are also invited to join us! There are two session options:

- **†** Wednesday evenings (weekly) from 6:45pm 8:00pm, (K to 7) OR
- **†** Sunday mornings (bi-weekly) from 10:15am 11:30am, (*Pre-K to 7*)

The Sunday session is structured as a Family Catechesis program. Students **and** parents meet every other week. Lesson plans for the "at-home" portion of the catechesis are given to the parents so that they may complete the lessons at home with their children during the weeks when classes are not held.



<u>SACRAMENT NOTES</u>: The children will be prepared to receive the sacraments of *Reconciliation and Eucharist* for the first time in 2nd grade. This is a *two-year* preparation process. Religious Education continues yearly after First Communion through 7th grade, when the students will receive the sacrament of *Confirmation* (*or possibly older, depending on when they began the preparation process*). Children who are older than 2nd grade, and who have not yet received their First Communion, are encouraged to register as soon as possible. We will evaluate the best placement for them based upon classes available.


