From The PASTOR

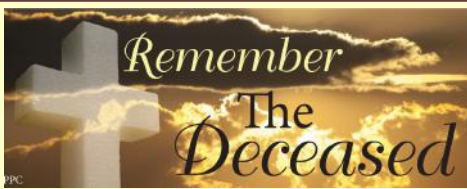
Dear Friends,

RCIA is Starting Soon!

If you or a family member or a friend are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, please consider joining our parish's RCIA program. RCIA is the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, and it addresses the fundamental questions that we all have, based on our common human experience. The program is an introduction to Catholic teaching and is focused on growing in relationship with Jesus Christ, by participating in a small faith-sharing community.

If you are a non-Catholic, or if you have been baptized but have not yet received any other sacraments, or if you are a practicing Catholic who wants to go deeper in learning about your faith, then RCIA could be a helpful step on your faith journey. Attending the program does not require a firm commitment right now, but is merely an opportunity to "come and see" what God might be calling you to.

Sessions will take place every Wednesday evening, from September through May, from 7:00pm to 8:30pm, in the Parish Center, starting on Wednesday, September 4th. Please join us if you're interested, either as a new inquirer exploring the possibility of becoming fully initiated into the Catholic Church, or as a team member who is currently practicing the faith but wanting to learn more and to help others on their journey. 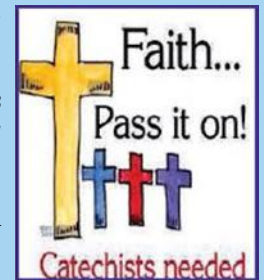
If you haven't yet registered your child/children, please do so today! This will help us to finalize our plans for the new year, including determining the number of volunteers and classrooms needed, textbooks, supplies, etc. **Registration is now done ONLINE.** The link is on the parish website's home page, ststanislaus.com, and under the Religious Education section. PREP is open to children starting in Kindergarten. *The Sunday session also includes your Pre-K children!* Sessions are available on Wednesday evenings and on Sunday mornings. The Sunday session includes both an in-class and home-school component. *Do you home-school your children for their regular schoolwork? Please contact us to discuss Religious Education options for them. We also welcome your call if you have questions or need to discuss any special circumstances.*



To prepare to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in 2nd grade, the children must complete Level 1 prior to entering Level 2. If your child was not enrolled beginning with Level 1 (usually 1st grade), it is never too late to get started. Please call us to discuss the options available!

St. Stanislaus is seeking creative individuals with a passion for their faith to fill a few remaining volunteer openings in our Parish Religious Education Program:

- † **Classroom aides** assist the catechist in his/her responsibilities. *(No preparation is required outside of class time.) We have openings in grade levels 1, 6 & 7 on Wednesdays and Level 7 on Sundays.*
