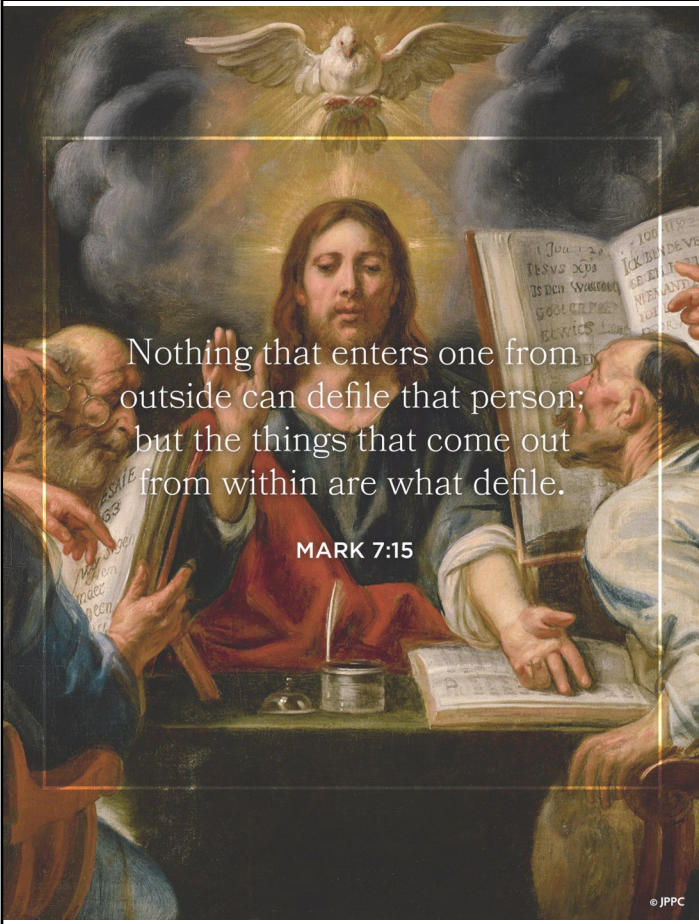

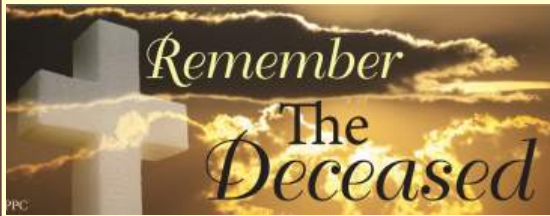

If you or a family member or a friend are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, please consider joining our parish's RCIA program. RCIA is the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, and it addresses the fundamental questions that we all have, based on our common human experience.
