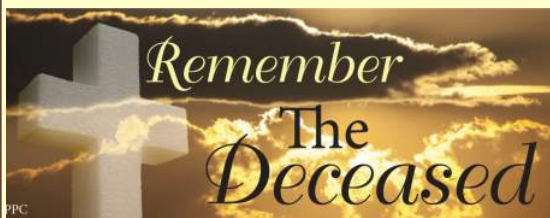

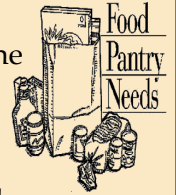
Hispanic Community Food Fundraiser Today!

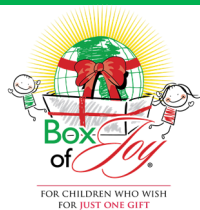

They will distribute the sock rolls to homeless shelters in the greater Philadelphia area. We made ~600 sock rolls last year! Overall, in 2024, *The Giving Tree* collected over 20,000 sock rolls, which were donated to local men's homeless shelters - that's a lot of socks!

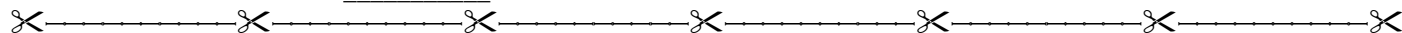
