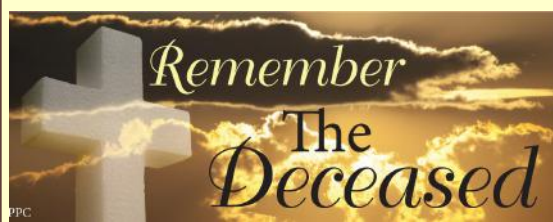

Liturgical Studies

Elements of the Catholic Mass Study Series

The Second Vatican Council declared that the faithful should participate in the liturgy “fully aware of what they are doing.” *Elements of the Catholic Mass* is designed to help the faithful better appreciate and understand the signs, symbols, gestures, words, and beauty of the Mass. Featuring Fr. Douglas Martis, former director of the Liturgical Institute, the program consists of thirty-one beautifully produced short videos (approximately 4 minutes long). The videos will be accompanied by guided discussion to further enhance understanding and provide answers to participants’ questions. The goals of this study group are to lead its members to a more fully conscious and active participation in the liturgy as well as to serve as an introduction to deeper studies on the Eucharist as we complete the final year of the National Eucharistic Revival.

We look forward to watching Mater Dei's 8th Graders grow as leaders in Faith, Excellence, Service, and Community this school year!

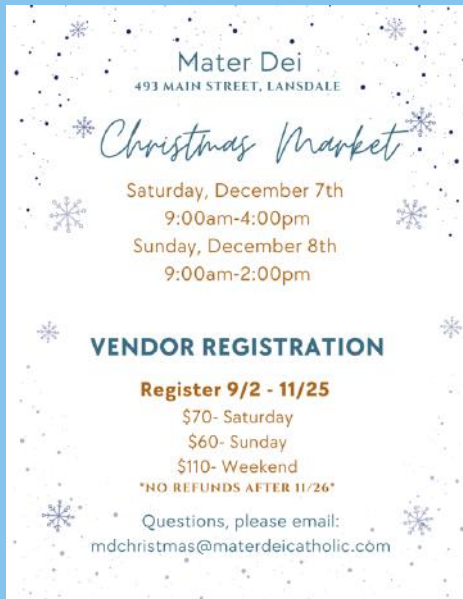

Do you like to work with little children? We have an opening for a **class aide** in one of our **Level 1** classes. Training and resources will be provided.

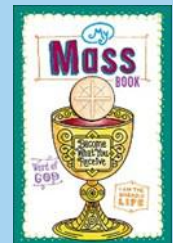
The **classroom aide openings for our Level 6 classes have not yet been filled.** The class aides take attendance, help with distributing and collecting paperwork, assist the children as needed and help to maintain a peaceful classroom environment. No preparation is needed outside of class time.

We are also looking for someone to be a **parking lot monitor** from **6:20pm - 6:50pm** and from **8:00pm - 8:15pm** on Wednesday evenings. It's now dark during PREP arrival and dismissal. Since there is a lot of traffic in and out of the parking lot during these times, we want to make sure that our PREP children and families stay safe! *You may choose to do the either arrival or dismissal time, or both!* Safety equipment is provided for your use.

All volunteers are required to have clearances and take two Safe Environment classes, as required by the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. **You do not need to have children in PREP to volunteer!** Contact Leona Russell, DRE, with questions or to apply! *God may be calling you!*

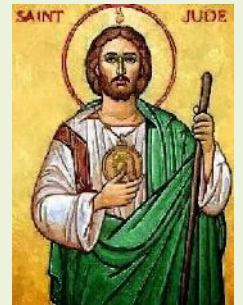
