a candle presented to a family member during Mass and each deceased person's name will be mentioned and prayed for. All are welcome!



The Second Vatican Council declared that the faithful should participate in the liturgy "fully aware of what they are doing." Elements of the Catholic Mass is designed to help the faithful better appreciate and understand the signs, symbols, gestures, words, and beauty of the Mass. Featuring Fr. 




