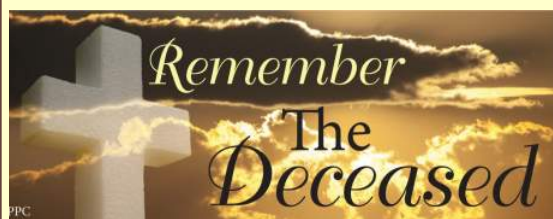

Elements of the Catholic Mass Study Series

The Second Vatican Council declared that the faithful should participate in the liturgy "fully aware of what they are doing." *Elements of the Catholic Mass* is designed to help the faithful better appreciate and understand the signs, symbols, gestures, words, and beauty of the Mass. Featuring Fr. Douglas Martis, former director of the Liturgical Institute, the program consists of thirty-one beautifully produced short videos (approximately 4 minutes long).
