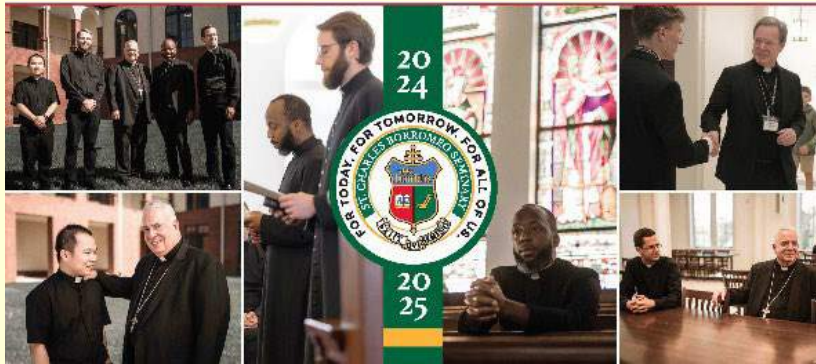

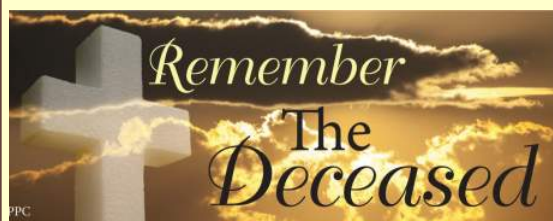

Liturgical Studies

Elements of the Catholic Mass Study Series

The Second Vatican Council declared that the faithful should participate in the liturgy “fully aware of what they are doing.” *Elements of the Catholic Mass* is designed to help the faithful better appreciate and understand the signs, symbols, gestures, words, and beauty of the Mass. Featuring Fr. Douglas Martis, former director of the Liturgical Institute, the program consists of thirty-one beautifully produced short videos (approximately 4 minutes long). The videos will be accompanied by guided discussion to further enhance understanding and provide answers to participants’ questions. The goals of this study group are to lead its members to a more fully conscious and active participation in the liturgy as well as to serve as an introduction to deeper studies on the Eucharist as we complete the final year of the National Eucharistic Revival.

The tilma was the cloak of Saint Juan Diego in Mexico on which the Blessed Virgin Mary imprinted a representation of herself. The image and the cloth are still miraculously intact almost 500 years later. As we acknowledge this important feast day upcoming in December, this topic is very timely. 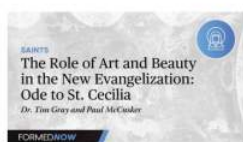

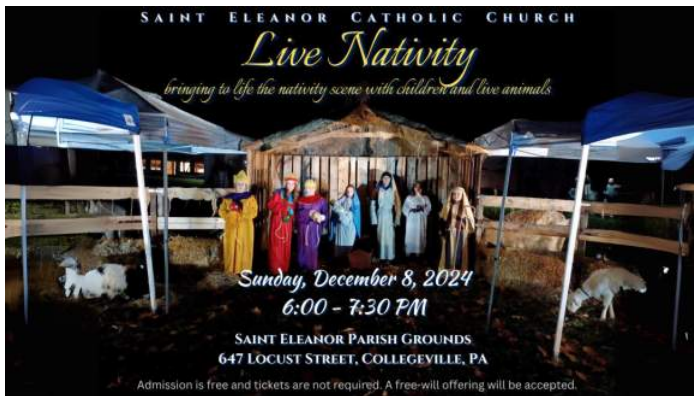
