



This month's topic is Our Lady of Guadalupe, Her Message, and The Tilma of Saint Juan Diego. Displaying a life-size replica of the cloth of Our Lady of Guadalupe, our guest presenter, Mr. Massimo Paris, researcher and lecturer, will share the results of his studies and the history and symbolism of the miraculous image, with its many amazing details. The tilma was the cloak of Saint Juan Diego in Mexico on which the Blessed Virgin Mary imprinted a representation of herself. The image and the cloth are still miraculously intact almost 500 years later. As we acknowledge this important feast day upcoming in December, this topic is very timely. Please join us to learn more.

Parish Advent Service Project

The 1st event for our new Parish Service Projects will take place on Saturday, December 14th, from 9am-11am in the Parish Center Lobby Meeting Room. The activity will be producing PLYARN (plastic-yarn) that will be delivered to "Integrate for Good", a training center for challenged young adults. They will weave the PLYARN into mats to be distributed to organizations and agencies that gift the mats to homeless persons, providing them with insulation from the cold and/or wet ground.

We will be recycling plastic shopping bags by cutting them into loops, linking the loops into a chain, then rolling the chain into a yarn-like ball. If you can join us, please bring a pair of long-bladed scissors (shears) and any plastic shopping bags you may have. If you do not have these items, please come anyway to help loop and roll the PLYARN.




Respect Life Corner
