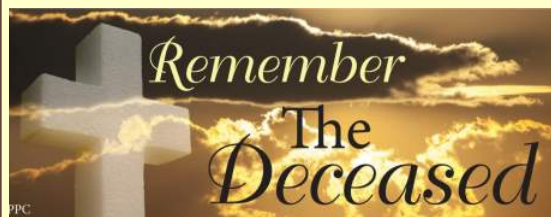

Elements of the Catholic Mass Study Series

The Second Vatican Council declared that the faithful should participate in the liturgy "fully aware of what they are doing." *Elements of the Catholic Mass* is designed to help the faithful better appreciate and understand the signs, symbols, gestures, words, and beauty of the Mass. Featuring Fr. Douglas Martis, former director of the Liturgical Institute, the program consists of thirty-one beautifully produced short videos (approximately 4 minutes long). The videos will be accompanied by guided discussion to further enhance understanding and provide answers to participants' questions. The goals of this study group are to lead its members to a more fully conscious and active participation in the liturgy as well as to serve as an introduction to deeper studies on the Eucharist as we complete the final year of the National Eucharistic Revival.

With the season of Advent upon us, are you feeling the hustle and bustle of the season? Feeling overwhelmed by the growing lists of things to do and places to go? As we prepare for the birth of Jesus this Advent, we need to find time to focus on Jesus as He is 'the reason for the season'.

Our Perpetual Adoration Chapel can provide a quiet, peaceful place for you to sit and pray or just sit and spend time with Jesus. Blessed Carlo Acutis (to be canonized in 2025) has said that *"holiness was impossible without Mass, the Rosary, and time before the Blessed Sacrament, saying "the Eucharist is the highway to heaven" and "by standing before the Eucharistic Christ, we become holy."*

Tips of Support from the Bereavement Ministry of MMR and St. Stanislaus parishes:

~Be supportive of the way the person chooses to handle the holidays. Some may wish to follow traditions; others may choose to avoid customs of the past and do something new. It's okay to do things differently.

~Invite the person to join you or your family during the holidays. You might invite them to join you for a religious service or at a holiday meal where they are a guest.

~Donate a gift or money in memory of the person's loved one. Remind the person that his or her loved one is not forgotten.

~Never tell someone that he or she should be "over it." Instead, give the person hope that, eventually, he or she will enjoy the holidays again.

~Be willing to listen. Active listening from friends and family is an important step to helping some cope with grief and heal.

~Remind the person that you are thinking of him or her and the loved one who died. Cards, phone calls and visits are great ways to stay in touch.

~Follow up after the holidays to check in. Given the activity of the season, some people may make it through the holidays without any issues but they might find the post-holiday period to be more difficult. So, checking in after the holidays to see how he or she may be doing is helpful.

Did you know that **less than 10%** of Catholics believe they have a personal relationship with Jesus or that such a relationship is even possible? The "Discovery" faith study will help you look deep inside your heart and discover how much Jesus loves you and wants an intimate, personal relationship with you. Running for 6 weeks (1 session per week), you will be paired up in small groups to help you grow your faith through discussion, and walk with one another.
